Norwoods Golf Club Rules

Format:

SCRAMBLE format, everyone plays from the same ball located in the best position. All ties will be settled by a scorecard playoff starting on the #1 handicap hole.

<u>Tee Assignment: **PLEASE NOTE**</u> Men shall play from the WHITE tee markers. Ages 70 & over and women shall play from the **RED** tee markers. Hole-in-One Competitions: Everyone must tee off from the WHITE tee markers.

Rules of Play:

- 1. If your ball or stance is affected by any sunken irrigation line in the fairway (only), you may find your nearest point of relief (no closer to the hole) and take a free drop.
- 2. You may take a free drop from any natural drainage ditch #16—just short off the green
 - #2—right of the green
 - #8—separates the two fairways
 - #9—just off the tee, short off green
 - #11—separates the two fairways
- #17—just off the tee
- #18—before you get to the fairway
- 3. Local Rule change for relief from Natural Drainage (You may take ONE CLUB LENGTH) from the edge of the ditch no closer to the hole and drop).
- 4. If your stance, swing or flight of the ball is interfered with by an electrical pole you may find your nearest point of relief, no closer to the hole, and take a free drop. (This relief does not apply to the power lines).
- 5. The inside edge of the main road and the gravel maintenance road on Hole #10 define out of bounds on that hole.
- 6. All ponds are hazards (they are unmarked) the margin of the hazard is defined by the edge of the pond banks.
- 7. There are drop circles on holes #4, 6, 10, 15 &17.
- The entire parking lot is out of bounds. 8.
- The road behind #2 and #9 greens and the area 9. beyond them is out of bounds. The out of bound behind #9 ends where the white line ends. The road and area beyond #15 green is in bounds (except parking lot).
- 10. Lateral Hazards and Water Hazards are marked by red and yellow stakes (movable obstruction).
- 11. Out of bounds are marked by white stakes or flags.

*If a flag or stake is missing out of a row then the boundary of the hazard is defined by the inside edge of the tall grass.
